

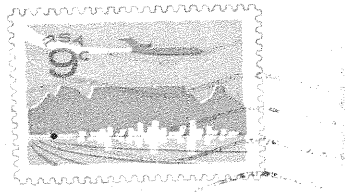
Dear Michael,
