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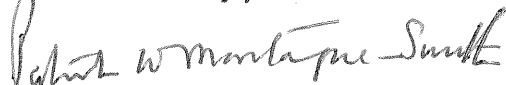

Dear Mr. MacDonald,

Thank you for your letter of 19th June, and for your interesting table of descent from Edward I. You may be interested to know that Edmund Earl of Kent married Margaret, daughter of John Lord Wake. There is on your table mention of John of Gaunt. He was a son of Edward III.

As regards the Earls of Hyndford, the fullest account is in the Scots Peerage edited by Sir James Balfour Paul, Lord Lyon King of Arms, Vol. IV published in 1907. The account of the family is from page 563 - 597 and you should be able to obtain photostats of this from most large libraries. I suggest that you try the Public Library, Edinburgh. This will give much more information than was published in Debrett.
